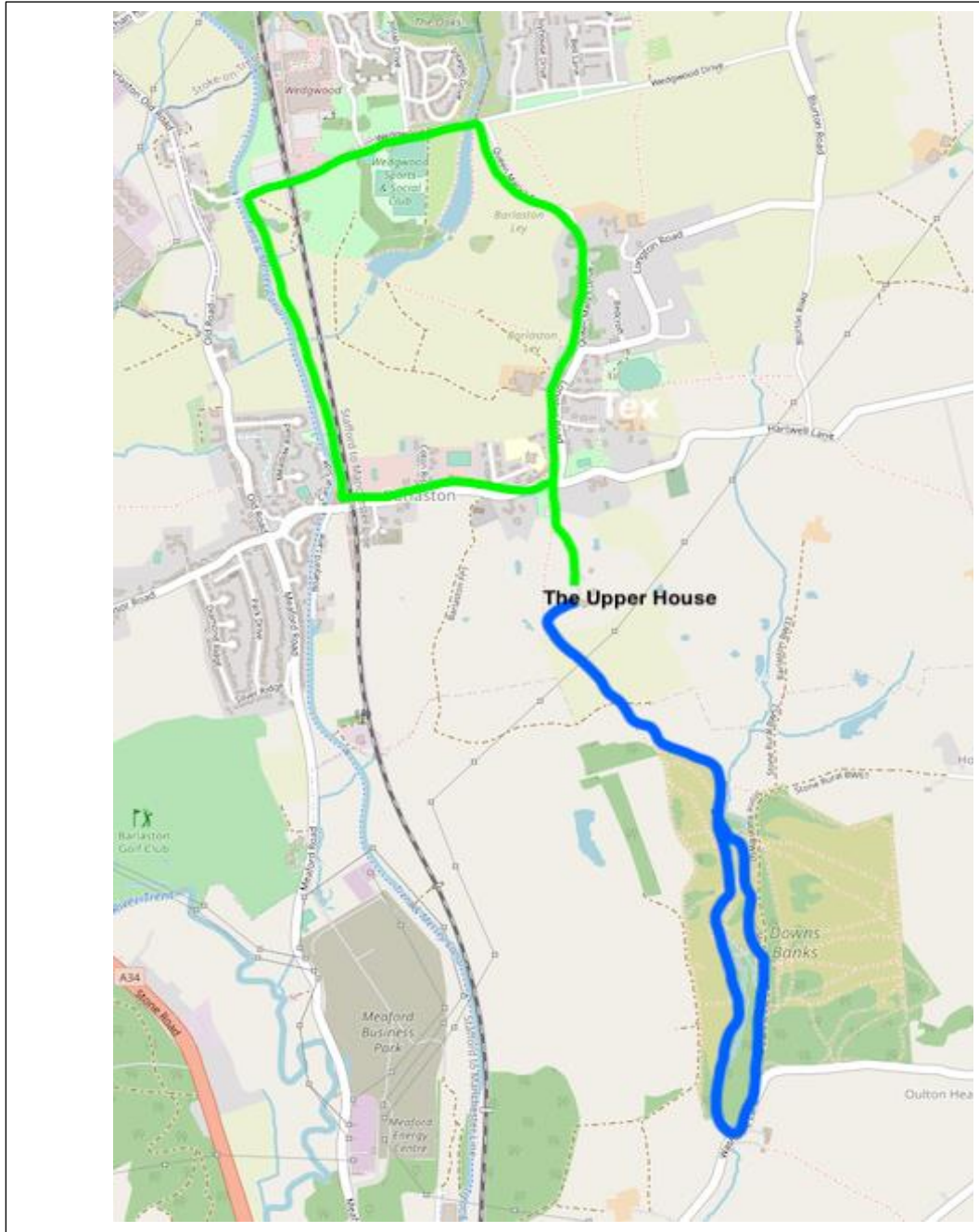


## Two nice walks from the Upper House Hotel



### **The Downs Bank walk. Blue**

At the cedar tree at the front of the hotel follow the path down across the hay field. Turn left at the foot path and follow it up, over a field, to the top of the Downs Bank. After the last gate turn left down a gravel path to the stream and keep right of the stream. Follow this all the way to a lane and turn left over the ford. Turn next left by the car park and follow the stream back up to where you joined it, by crossing a wooden bridge, on your left. Retrace your steps back to the hotel.

3.25 miles 300 feet elevation. Muddy in the winter.

### **The Wedgwood Estate walk. Green**

Walk down the drive to the road and cross straight over. Careful of cars from the right. Follow the road until the next left which takes you past Barlaston Hall & Church. Carry on down the drive with the lake on the left and turn left at the junction. Wedgwood visitor centre is on your right. Carry on until you cross the canal bridge and join the tow path going left, which brings you back to Barlaston, by the pub. Turn left onto the road and walk up to the hill using the footpath on the left hand side until you come back to the hotel drive. 2.9 miles, 170 feet elevation.
